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1. Summary Update

I would like to take this opportunity to again express my respect, appreciation and admiration for all colleagues and co-workers in Ochil Tower for their continued commitment and dedication to providing the safest and best quality education and care to the children and young people over the past ten months. The perseverance of all to find the best approach and way of working to support the young people has been remarkable and I am indebted to all for the continued ability to do this with courtesy and, when possible, humour.

I would like also to thank the Senior Leadership Team (SLT) for pursuing the prioritisation of colleagues in Ochil Tower to receive the Covid 19 vaccination with such vigour. Their efforts have now paid off and vaccinations have commenced. Hopefully this will enable us to move forward again in coming months.

Following the First Minister's announcement of the second lock down in January, the SLT quickly moved to review all the previously developed policies, procedures and protocols and to update these where required. An individual risk assessment has been undertaken for each child and young person in consultation with families and local authorities. These have sought to assess, on a case by case basis, the risks and benefits to the young person around returning to the services in January or in supporting their learning from home. We seek to follow relevant Scottish Government and Care Inspectorate guidance and advice, placing appropriate measures in place while continuing to provide our young people with the best quality care, support and learning possible.

We continue to reflect and take stock of our approaches and services, developing creative and innovative approaches to address the challenges we have been presented with. Our recovery and renewal plan links directly to the Scottish Government's previous requirements and will be adjusted again in light of a future route map. The tables below remain based on the previously envisaged four recovery phases (please refer to the full OTS Recovery and Renewal plan August 2020). It is important to note that our steps continue to be subject to change in accordance with continuing Scottish Government, Care Inspectorate and Education Scotland advice.

We will continue to keep families, local authorities and other stakeholders up to date as we respond to each new Government directive. We will maintain relevant contact both around the individual child and young person's circumstances and on an organisational level.

In spite of the circumstances, our young people continue to make positive gains. Colleagues and co-workers work hard to maintain daily routines and continue to provide high quality services. The Board of Trustees remains actively involved in our approach to adapting to the constraints required to limit the impact of the pandemic in Ochil Tower and provides us with guidance and support.
